Foreword

Unanimity among growers is rare – but without exception, all described the growing conditions they experienced in 2024 as the most difficult they could remember. One used the word nightmare. Weather patterns during the growing season were very unusual from the beginning, and it became clear from the outset that the eventual quality of 2024 vintage would be made in the vineyards, with fine wines made only by those prepared to spend the time – and resources – on a huge effort in the vines.

February was exceptionally mild, and March exceptionally wet with downpours on an almost daily basis. Budburst took place from the 3rd week of March, in good time to incur some frost damage during April. This was particularly serious in the Mâconnais on the night of 26th-27th.

But the real problems began in May. On 1st May, a severe storm in Chablis caused extensive damage which greatly reduced the eventual size of the crop. This was followed by rain throughout Burgundy on 22 days of the month, and set the scene for a very poor flowering from early June, in cold and wet conditions. The result: extensive *coulure* (the failure of fruit to set) and *millerandage* (uneven fruit set within the same bunch). This particularly affected Pinot Noir and, according to one grower, was more pronounced in old vines than in younger plantings. Rainstorms continued throughout much of June and July, creating the perfect conditions for mildew which affected not just the leaves but also the bunches. Grower after grower repeated that only those who expanded their vineyard teams, and treated quickly and often – even being prepared to go out on the tractors on a Sunday – were able to keep the mildew at bay. Céline Fontaine for example reported 16 separate sprayings, while Benoit Riffault (Sauzet) reported 18. Inevitably, the lower lying and flatter vineyard sites were the worst affected. Canopy management was also essential – removal of leaves and cutting (or eliminating) grass between the rows to maximise aeration and exposure of the fruit.

There was some respite in late July and early August, but the rain returned, and there was also some localised hail damage, particularly in St Aubin. Finally in the second week of September, a cool and drying north wind brought much relief, concentrating the juice and preventing the onset of rot. This allowed picking to take place in broadly good conditions.

This may all sound somewhat apocalyptic, and probably would have resulted in a disastrous vintage in the 1970s, 80s or 90s. But with the much wider experience of the younger generation of growers, most of whom have worked in other parts of the world, and with more advanced techniques both in the vineyards and in the cuveries, those who worked diligently in the vines have produced some very fine wines indeed. The good reds are fine and pure expressions of Pinot, and the whites are widely regarded as outstanding. Alcohols are back to more classic levels – with up to a degree of Chaptalisation bringing most to between 12.5% and 13.5%. All agree that with such purity of fruit, and elegance of style, the expression of *terroir* is exceptional in this vintage.

2024 is a grower's vintage, where the quality is more than ever made in the vineyards. It is arguably therefore a Burgundy lover's vintage as it captures so beautifully the nuances and the essence, and also the capriciousness, of this greatest of wine regions.

Domaine Marc-Antonin Blain

Marc-Antonin Blain, son of Jean-Marc Blain and Claudine née Gagnard, has his cellars next door to his parents in Chassagne. He has 3 hectares of his own, and is taking on more as his grandmother Marie-Joseph Gagnard has all but stopped production at Domaine Gagnard Delagrange, and his father himself moves towards retirement. In addition, he and his sister Lucie bought vineyards in Brouilly some years ago, where Marc-Antonin makes seriously impressive Beaujolais. After growing up in the village, Marc-Antonin travelled widely in Australia and New Zealand, working with a number of different producers, and it was really as a result of this time abroad that he decided to become a winemaker. Returning home, he began by working with his maternal grandfather, Jacques Gagnard (see Domaine Gagnard Delagrange below); this apprenticeship, as well as his father's example, laid the foundations for today's brilliance. Grapes were picked from 14th to 24th September.

Pierre Bourée Fils

In the 19th century, Pierre Bourée took over a small négociant house in Gevrey Chambertin which had been founded in 1864. Over the years he built up his vineyard holdings, adding the domaine's *monopole*, Clos de la Justice, in 1902. He was succeeded by his son Bernard in 1922, and Bernard's two nephews Louis and François Vallet joined the firm after the 2nd World War. Today, François Vallet's son Jean-Christophe is in charge, with his son Vincent working alongside him. A new winery and cellar have been built, two or three doors down from the main premises in Gevrey, and the large space makes for much more practical and efficient cellar work than the old – though picturesque – cellar. 40% of the wines produced come from Bourée's own vineyards, with the rest purchased as grapes. This is a fabulous source, comparatively little known on the UK market, of classically styled wines. Gevrey was the commune most badly affected by the conditions in 2024, so the crop here was very small

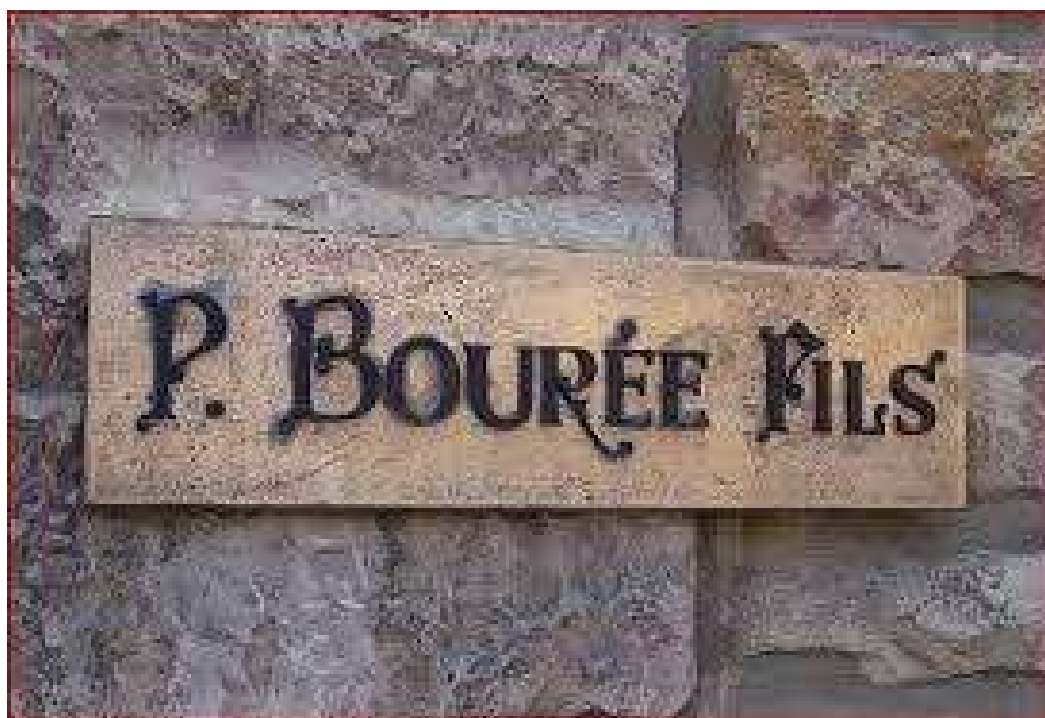

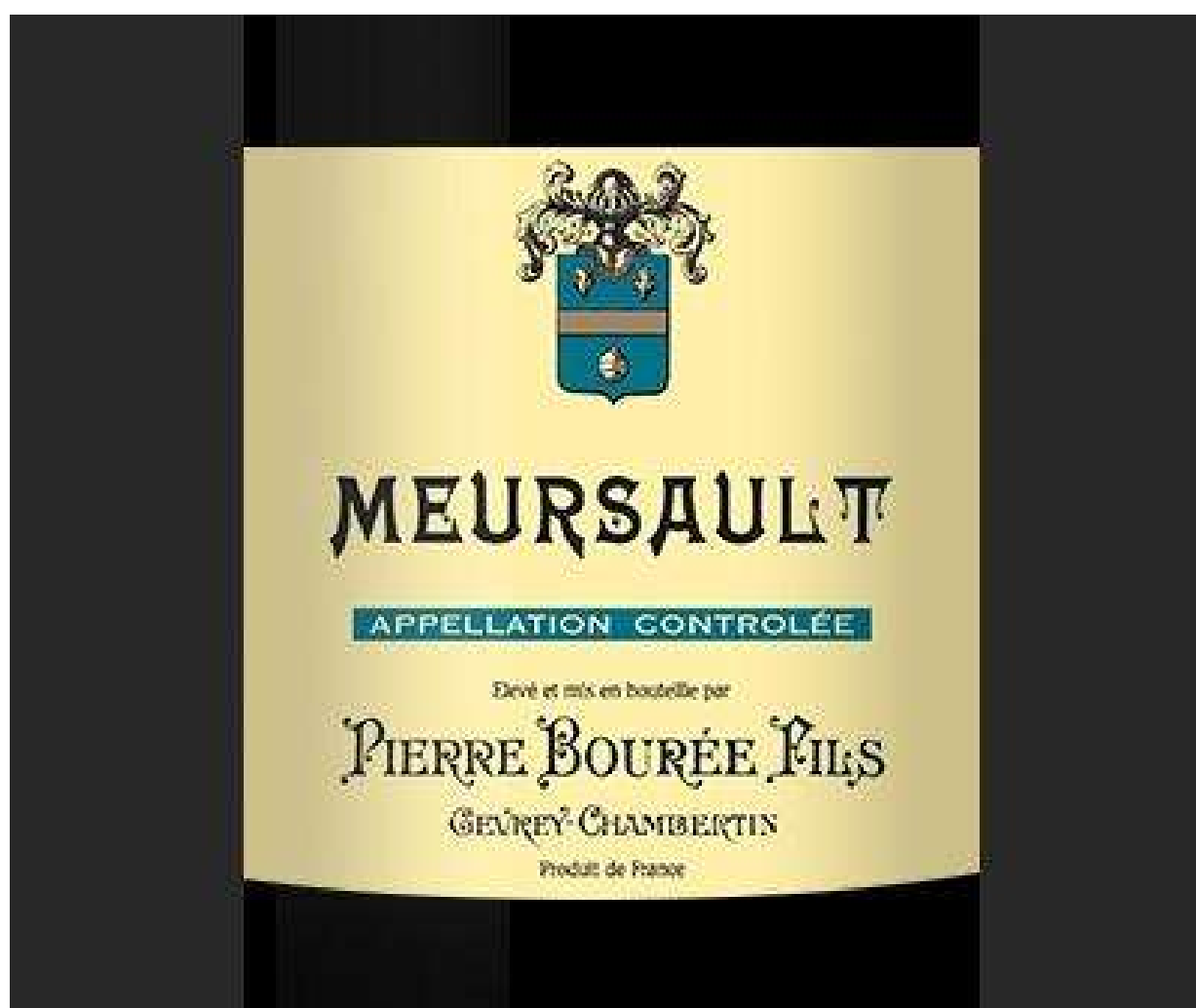

Domaine Faiveley

The Faiveley cellars in Nuits are a sight to behold – beautiful limestone arches deep below ground, where the largest vineyard owner in Burgundy continues to make and age its wines. The house was founded in 1825 by Pierre Faiveley. The foundations of its modern success however were laid by Georges Faiveley, who saw the firm through the difficult inter-war years when it was said that a new barrel cost more than the wine which filled it. His grandson François handed control to his own son Erwan – the 7th generation – in 2005. Over the last 20 years, the winemaking has become more refined and precise, and these have become some of Burgundy's finest. Yields were especially low in the Côte de Nuits: an average of 15 hectolitres per hectare compared with 50 hl/ha in 2023 vintage. In 2023, 25 barrels of Latricières were produced; in 2024 this fell to just 3 barrels. Picking began on 12th September, and was completed in just 12 days.

Domaine Ferret

This famous 18 hectare estate in Fuissé was bought by Maison Louis Jadot in 2006, but we have worked with the wines since the 1990s. The domaine was founded by the Ferret family in 1840, and enlarged by Antoine Ferret in the late 19th century. It was however Jeanne Ferret, who took over the running of the domaine in the late 1920s when her husband died, who really put it on the map. She was the first to make single vineyard wines in Pouilly Fuissé (in the 1930s) and began domaine-bottling during the Second World War. In the 1970s she established a hierarchy of vineyard classification, with Tête de Cru being the equivalent of 1er Cru, and Hors Classe the equivalent of Grand Cru. Jeanne died in 1993 and was succeeded by her daughter Collette, and on her death, Jadot bought the estate. A new winery was built in the village in 2011, and everything is vinified and bottled on site. The brilliant young winemaker, Clément Robinet, took over in June 2023. He described the 24 as a small crop, down by about 20%, because of the terrible weather during flowering. Picking however took place in perfect conditions, beginning on 12th September.

Over the next 25 years, the wines achieved even greater renown thanks to the incredible talents of the winemaker, Didier Séguier. Now under the ownership of Domaines Baron de Rothschild, the future for this great domaine looks exceptionally bright – and Didier continues to make some of the greatest wines of the Chablis appellation.

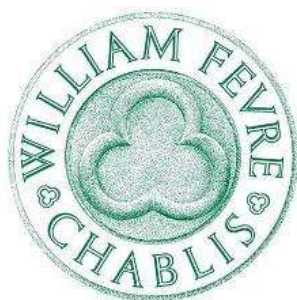

Domaine Fontaine Gagnard

This 12 hectare domaine is widely regarded as one of the finest in Chassagne. It was established by Richard Fontaine and his wife Laurence (daughter of Jacques and Marie-Joseph Gagnard), and based on vineyards bought by Laurence's grandfather, Edmond Delagrangé. Today it is run by Richard and Laurence's daughter Céline and her partner Frédéric Robert; since 2023 Céline has had a completely free hand as her father has now fully stepped back. In addition, the vineyards have been augmented by those passed on by Céline's grandmother, thus maintaining volumes despite the small crop. As with many domaines, extra people were employed during the growing season to sustain the level of vineyard work required by the conditions. Picking began on 12th September and finished on 18th. The results are spectacular – a great vintage for Fonaine.

Domaine Gagnard Delagrange

Marie-Josèphe Gagnard, a remarkably spritely 80-something, has run this domaine since her husband Jacques Gagnard died in 2009. The winemaking has been overseen variously by her grandson Marc-Antonin Blain, her son-in-law Jean-Marc Blain, and her granddaughter Céline Fontaine. She has gradually passed her vineyards on to her children and grandchildren, and 2023 was essentially the last vintage bottled at this domaine – with some further stock released for sale this year. Marie-Joseph has just kept her parcel of village Chassagne Blanc, which she refers to as “mon jardin” as the vines literally form the back garden of her house. 2024 will be the last vintage even for this plot. We finished our tasting with the customary old bottle – a 1996 Bâtard. A great treat.

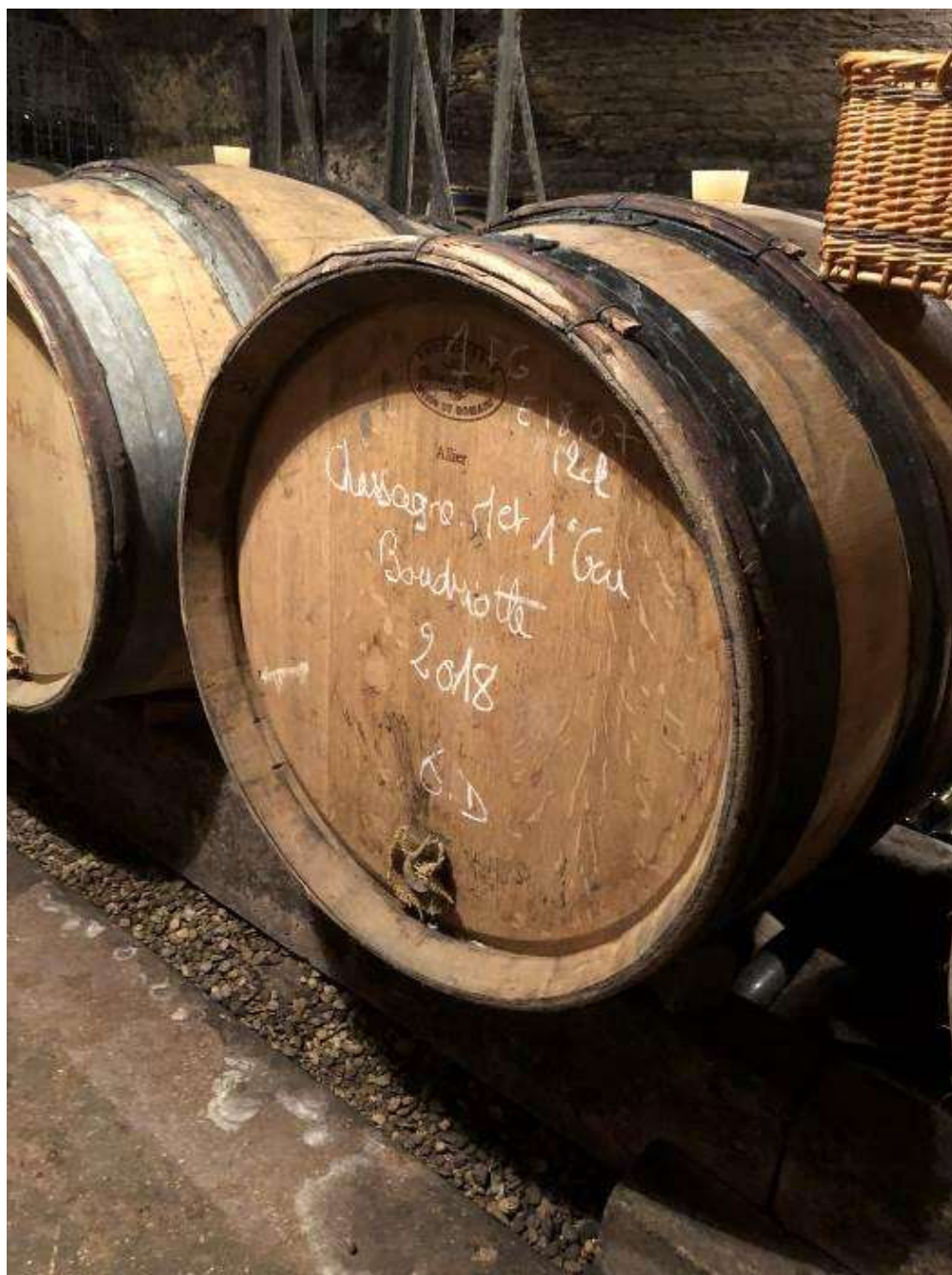

Domaine Jean-Michel Gaunoux et Fils

This 6 hectare domaine in Meursault was established by Jean-Michel Gaunoux, son of François Gaunoux, in 1990. The wines are now mostly made by his son Henri, whose mother, Delphine, is the daughter of the late Alain Hudelot, so there is also a close connection with Domaine Hudelot Noëllat. The vineyards are farmed without pesticides, and vinification methods are strictly traditional, with new oak kept to a modest 30% maximum. Wines are bottled without fining or filtration. These are wines of precision and freshness, and will inevitably gain attention as Henri establishes his growing reputation.

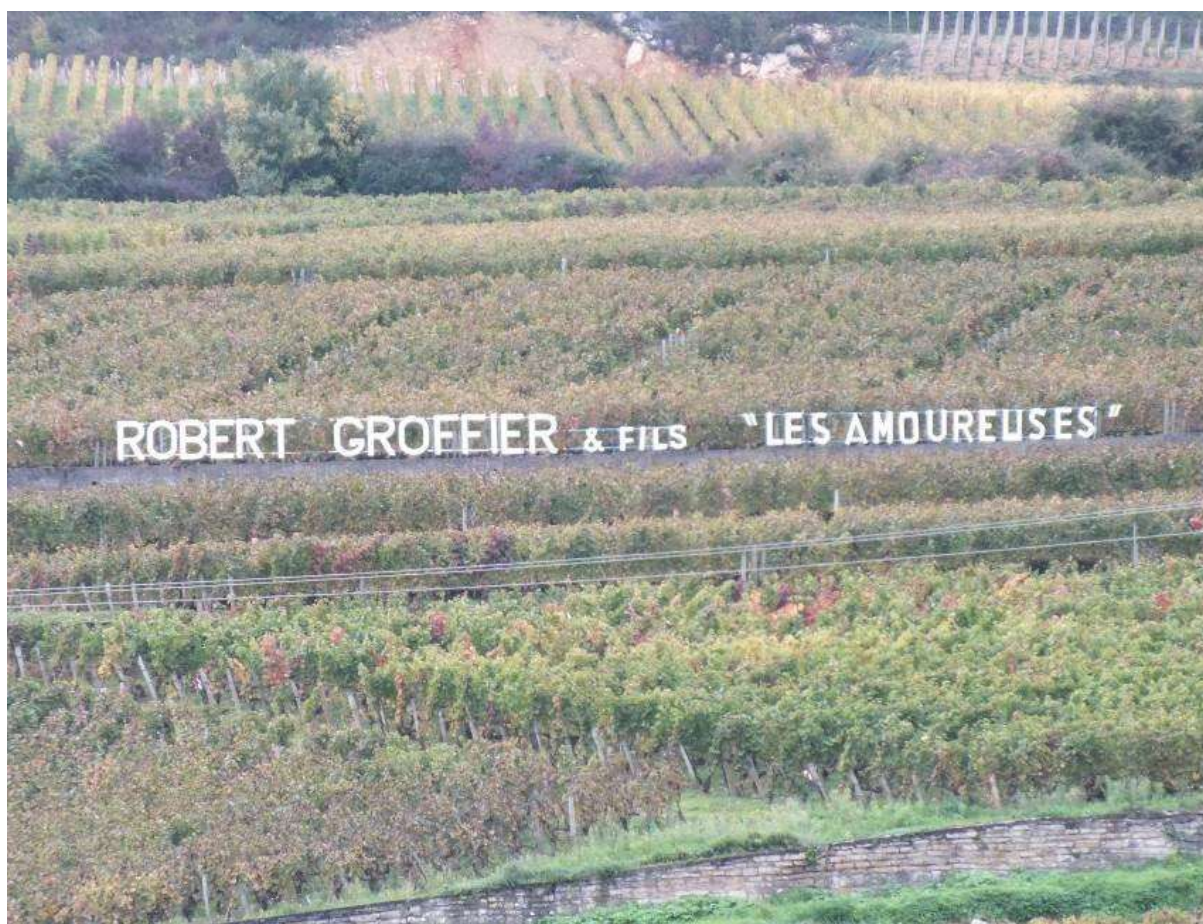

Domaine Robert Groffier

Nicolas Groffier makes some of the greatest wines of the Côte de Nuits at this outstanding domaine. His grandfather Robert, a truly charming old-fashioned Burgundian, put it on the map in the 1980s and 1990s; his son Serge built on the reputation which Robert established; and Serge's son Nicolas, with the help of his wife Céline, has taken it to new heights. The domaine is the largest owner in Chambolle's greatest 1er Cru vineyard, Les Amoureuses, as well as having a number of other very fine appellations. At the lower end of the appellation scale, the village (Gevrey) and regional (Bourgognes) wines are of absolutely brilliant quality and, particularly in the case of the Passetoutgrain, represent extraordinary value for money. Picking began on 17th September, and nothing was destemmed in 2024.

Château des Jacques

Purchased by Louis Jadot in November 1996, Château des Jacques' 69 hectares of vineyards are spread out across six individual appellations within the region. They are planted on the best sites, and the Château is gradually working towards the organic certification for all of their vineyards. All the parcels are vinified separately at the Château des Jacques winery in Romanèche-Thorins, to give the best flexibility and control for blending and releasing wines as individual 'Clos' which each reflect their specific 'terroir'. The estate is recognised for its practice of traditional fermentation where for more than 40 years, the Gamay grapes have been fermented like Pinot Noir in open tanks with *pigeage* and destemming. The wines are aged in oak barrels for about a year before bottling, in the wonderful 17th century cellars of the château. The winemaker, Julie Pitoiset, reported good weather in August, and that picking started on 9th September.

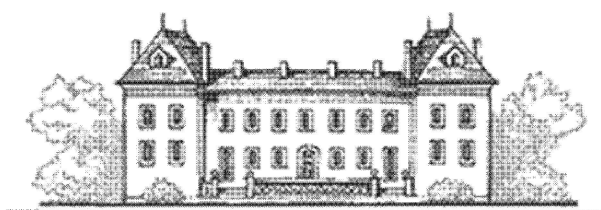

This great estate was founded by Denis Latour when he purchased his first vineyards in 1731. He was succeeded by Jean who was the first to buy property in Aloxe Corton, and Maison Louis Latour was founded by Louis in 1797, when the post-revolutionary chaos and suppression of the monasteries made the acquisition of vineyards suddenly wide open. The cuverie at Château Corton Grancey was built in 1830. Today, Maison Louis Latour is run by Florent Latour – the eleventh generation – and owns 48 hectares of vineyards. With 27 hectares of Grand Cru, it is the largest owner of Grand Cru vineyards in the Côte d'Or. We had a comprehensive tasting when we visited Corton Grancey in October, and are delighted to propose a selection from this famous address.

Domaine Jean-Pierre Maldant

Pierre-François Maldant runs this domaine of 9.3 hectares, with its cellars in Ladoix, where the family has been since 1895. In the past, they looked after the vineyards belonging to the Hospices de Beaune around Ladoix and Aloxe Corton, while production from their own vines was mostly sold in bulk. In 1998 things changed when they decided to bottle their own wines, setting out to build up a local clientele. Investments were made to revamp the vineyards and cellars and the modern facility next to the Domaine is used for state-of-the-art storage and labelling. Picking began on 21st September. Most was done quickly, but the vines in the Hautes Côtes weren't picked until 5th October. The disparity in yields between red and white illustrates the difficulties of the growing season: 30hl/ha for red as against 45hl/ha for white. Everything was destemmed.

Domaine Jean-Marc Millot

Jean-Marc and his wife Christine (née Gouroux) began bottling their production in 1992, but didn't obtain full control of their 4.5ha of vines until 1997. Most of their Grand Cru holdings come from Christine's family. Since then the size of the domaine has gradually increased to almost 8ha, and has gained a very fine reputation. Since 2016 it has been run by their daughter Alix with real brilliance. She operates from lovely old cellars in Nuits St Georges and works assiduously to produce pure, soft, mesmerising Burgundies with the accent firmly on the quality of the aromas and the fruit. Demand for these wines has increased rapidly in recent years, and quantities produced remain very limited. This situation is greatly exacerbated by the conditions in 2024 – yields averaged an paltry 20-25hl/ha with therefore dramatic reductions in volumes – the Bourgogne Rouge fell from 18 barrels in 23 to just 6 in 24. Fruit was picked from 18th to 23rd September.

Fernand died in 1964, leaving Marc to build for the future – in 1972 new buildings were erected, and in 1977 Marc and Madeleine installed their daughter Marie-Josèphe and son-in-law Bernard Mollard, before retiring in 1981. Sabine, their daughter, began working at the domaine in 2003. Her wines win friends every time we show them as they are superbly made, versatile & incredibly ‘user friendly’. Volumes are down by between 25 and 30 per cent thanks to the difficult flowering. Picking began on 15th September and took place during a week of good weather, with a northerly wind which dried and concentrated the fruit. Sabine described 24 as a classic, cool, fresh vintage – and her fabulous wines bear this out.

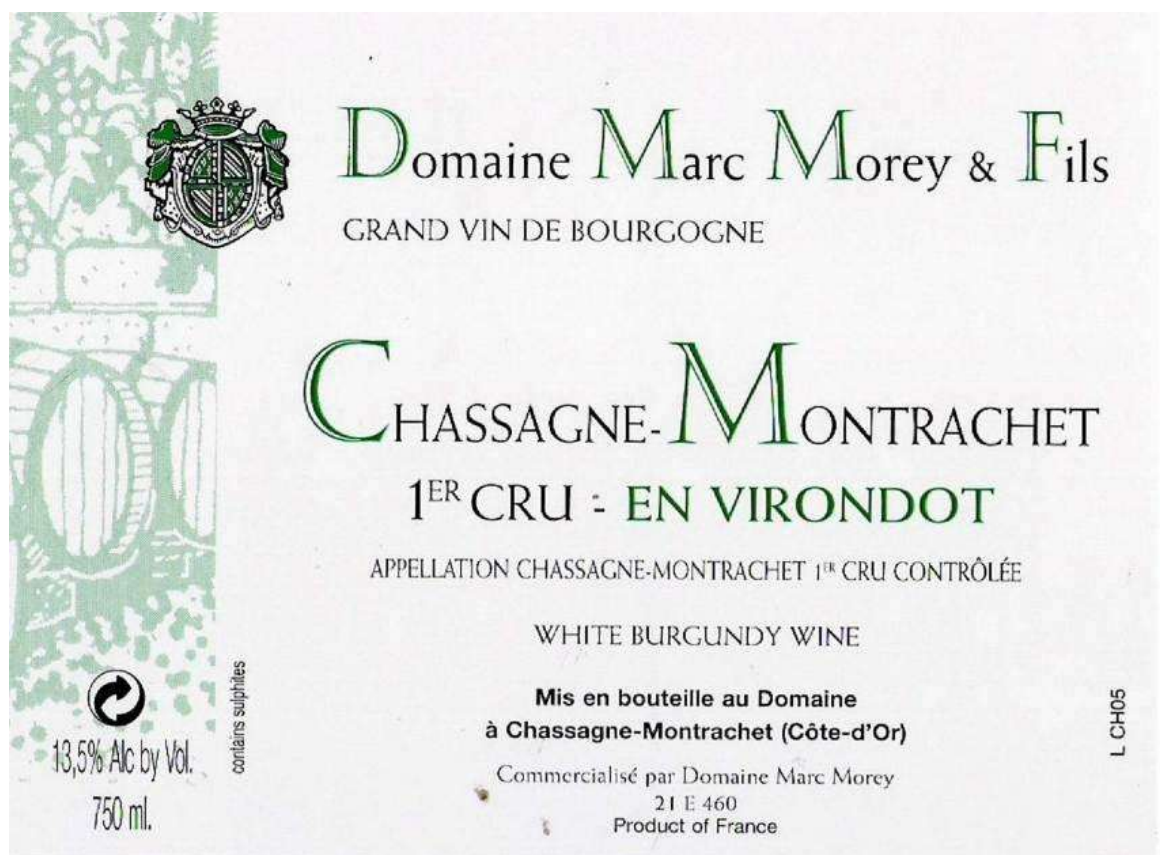

Florent Rouve

Florent has been running this domaine and négociant since 2013, using cellar and winery space at Domaine des Deux Roches in Davayé. It was established in 1998 by Jean and Régine Rijckaert, after Jean had worked alongside Jean-Marie Guffens (of Domaine Guffens Heynen and Verget fame) since 1990. There are 4 hectares of vines in the Mâconnais, and 5 hectares (and a separate winery) in the Jura town of Villette-les-Arbois. The wines here offer really brilliant value as the prices commanded by these appellations are a long way short of their peers in the Côte d'Or; and Florent is a brilliant winemaker, coaxing levels of complexity rarely seen in wines from these regions. The growing season in the Mâconnais was further complicated by frost damage during the night of 26th-27th April, and volumes are down by around 25%. Picking began on 10th September. Florent has decided to extend the time in barrel for the Jura wines – and so from this year, these will be released a year later – so we offer the 24s from the Mâconnais, and the 23s from the Jura.

Quantities are small, and everything is ‘*village*’ – though the exceptional quality which she coaxes from her vines gives the impression of much grander terroir. This is a source for wines of the most exquisite fragrance and purity. Picking began on 13th September, and yields were barely 30hl/ha.

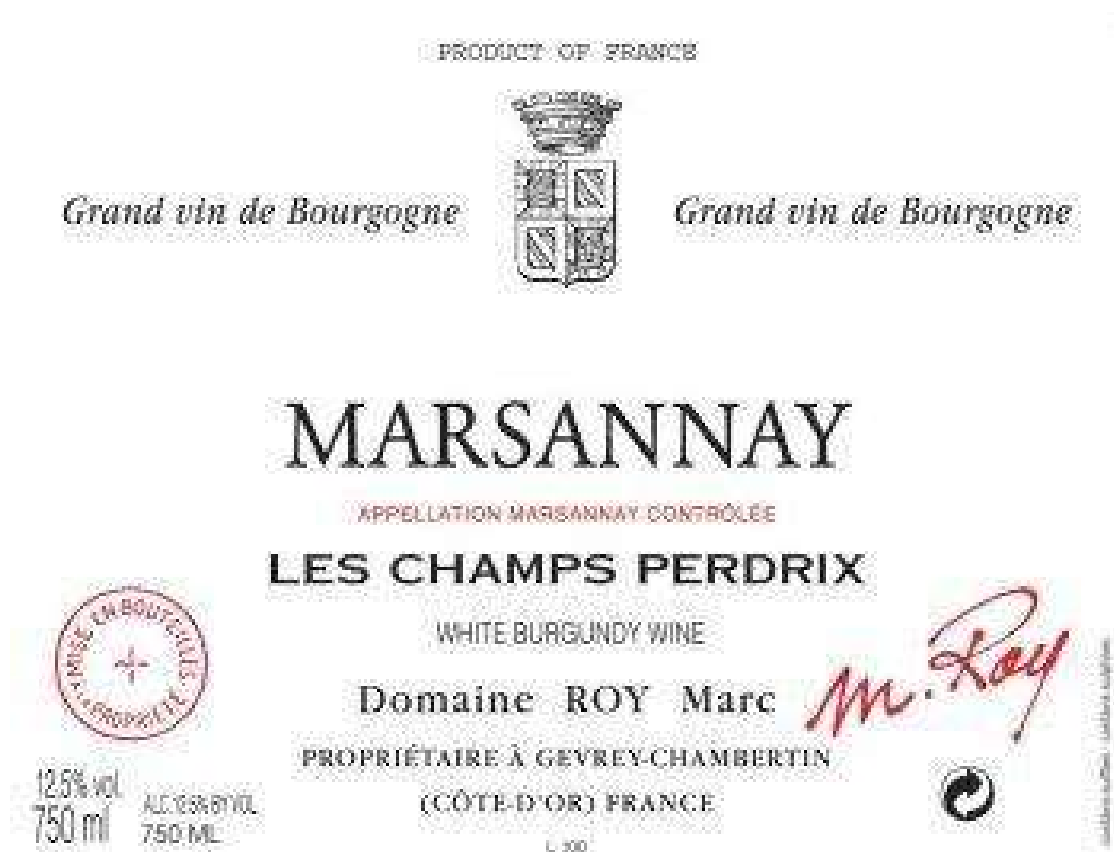

Etienne Sauzet

Emilie Boudout and her husband Benoît Riffault run this estate, founded by Emilie's great-grandfather Etienne Sauzet in the early 20th century, having taken over from Emilie's parents, Gérard and Jeanine (granddaughter of Etienne) Boudot. Originally there were about 12 hectares of vines, but in 1991 the domaine was split between the three grandchildren of Etienne, one of whom decided to take his share out. The grapes are now supplied by three members of the extended Sauzet family, and are supplemented by purchases of fruit from two growers with whom Gérard built long-term relationships. These are among the most highly prized whites of the Côte d'Or and we are fortunate to receive an allocation. Picking began on 12th September and finished on 24th, with some pauses in between. Volumes produced are down by almost half compared with 2023.

Domaine Tollot Beaut

This important domaine was established in Chorey Les Beaune by François Tollot in 1880; today its 25 hectares are run by brothers Jean-Paul and Olivier Tollot, and their cousin Nathalie Tollot, from lovely cellars in the heart of the village. The wines are made in a most compelling style, and have proved themselves over many years to be utterly dependable for delivering delicious, characterful and classically styled Pinots. A team of 60 pickers began their work on 16th September. Many of the pickers come from families which have been picking here since the days of Nathalie's grandfather – so there is a rare and remarkable continuity of vineyard knowledge among the pickers – especially useful in complicated vintages. Canopy management was particularly important in 2024 – and so the team working in the vineyards in May, June and July was increased from 10 to 16 people to cope with this additional work. The crop was about 25% smaller than usual, though not as small as in 2016 and 2021. All the fruit was destemmed.

Domaine Aurélien Verdet

Aurélien Verdet is remarkable for his energy and enthusiasm, constantly working on ways to expand the vineyard holdings he controls. His father Alain, one of the early pioneers of organic viticulture in Burgundy, began with 4.5ha, and retired in 2005. Since then, Aurélien has built a new winery in Arcenant, in the Hautes Côtes de Nuits, and now controls some 25ha of vines. Picking began on 16th September and production varied from 20hl-32h/ha depending on appellation. Aurélien said his aim was to make wines which are elegant, fruit-driven and pure in 2024, similar in style to 2021 vintage, avoiding over-extraction at all costs.
